**Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Works to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$100,000 from the Coastal Resources Grant Program for the Ocean Beach Erosion Control Project in the City and County of San Francisco.**

WHEREAS, Ocean Beach, the largest stretch of public sandy beach in San Francisco, suffered severe erosion in vast sections due to harsh winter storms in recent years; and,

WHEREAS, Erosion also threatens the Great Highway with its sewage facility located beneath the roadway that carries sewage from San Francisco's northwest quadrant to the Oceanside Treatment Plant at the southern end of Ocean Beach; and,

WHEREAS, The protection of life safety and property is most severely compromised just south of Sloat Boulevard where the ocean comes within twenty-five feet of the Highway; and,

WHEREAS, The California Legislature by A.B. 205 created the Coastal Resources Grant Program in 1991; and,

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works applied for \$100,000 under the Coastal Resources Grant Program 2001 –2002 Grant Cycle for the Ocean Beach Erosion Control Project in June 2001;

WHEREAS, The Resources Agency of California granted \$100,000 for San Francisco's Ocean Beach Erosion Control Project in January 2002; and

WHEREAS, State funding will cover ninety percent of eligible costs as defined and administered by the Resources Agency of California; and,
