

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - Centers for Disease Control and Prevention - DP21-  
2 2111 Closing the Gap with Social Determinants of Health Accelerator Plans - \$125,000]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**  
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$125,000 from the Centers for Disease Control and**  
5 **Prevention for participation in a program, entitled “DP21-2111 Closing the Gap with**  
6 **Social Determinants of Health Accelerator Plans,” for the period of September 30, 2021,**  
7 **through September 29, 2022.**

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9 WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has agreed to  
10 fund the Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$125,000 for participation in a  
11 program, entitled “DP21-2111 Closing the Gap with Social Determinants of Health Accelerator  
12 Plans,” for the period of September 30, 2021, through September 29, 2022; and

13 WHEREAS, Chronic disease is disproportionately impacting the San Franciscans of  
14 Black/African American ancestry to an extreme degree; and

15 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Black African American-focused Social Determinants  
16 of Health (SDOH) Accelerator plan to improve the Black African American health disparities  
17 by focusing on two social determinants: Food Security, and Community-Clinical Linkages; and

18 WHEREAS, The Accelerator plan will focus on disparity in cardiovascular disease  
19 incidence and severity, and the food and nutrition needed to prevent and manage  
20 cardiovascular disease; and

21 WHEREAS, The Leadership team developing the Accelerator plan will include  
22 representatives of clinical providers, community-based organizations, a nationally recognized  
23 academic institution, DPH, the San Francisco Human Services Agency, and residents with  
24 lived experience; and

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1           WHEREAS, The Leadership team will cross-train to gain a shared understanding, then  
2 meet regularly within a collective impact framework to generate a shared objective, metrics,  
3 proposed activities, and evaluation plan; and

4           WHEREAS, These recommendations will be evaluated using a Health Equity Impact  
5 Tool, then be presented to the community and potential partners as an action plan for  
6 improving the health of the Black/African American community; and

7           WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and

8           WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received  
9 the agreement on September 13, 2021, for a project start date of September 30, 2021; and

10          WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on  
11 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

12          RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in  
13 the grant budget; and, be it

14          FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
15 expend a grant in the amount of \$125,000 from the CDC; and, be it

16          FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
17 expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

18          FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
19 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

20          FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the Grant Agreement being fully  
21 executed by all parties, the Director of Health shall provide a copy to the Clerk of the Board of  
22 Supervisors for inclusion in the official file.
