Resolution retroactively authorizing the Fire Department to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 from the California Office of Emergency Services to purchase one hose tender for the performance period of July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2022, and waiving indirect costs.

WHEREAS, The Fire Department (SFFD) responds to over 150,000 incidents each year, including fires, vehicle accidents, and medical and other emergencies; and

WHEREAS, The Department would make use of the City's Emergency
Firefighting Water System (EFWS) in a natural disaster or other large-scale fire incident;
and

WHEREAS, Hose tenders have been identified as a crucial tool to support the function of the EFWS and the City's water supply in an emergency; and

WHEREAS, The SFFD was awarded an allocation of \$1,000,000 in the State of California's Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Budget Act to purchase one hose tender; and

WHEREAS, The documentation for the award to purchase equipment was prepared by the SFFD and are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 200025; and

WHEREAS, The use of these funds would allow the Department to purchase one new hose tender to supplement the four units allocated in the City's budget process; and

WHEREAS, This funding will be administered by the California Office of Emergency Services with a period of performance from July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, The Fire Commission recommended approval of this grant at its meeting on October 9, 2019; and

WHEREAS, The award does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; and

WHEREAS, There are no matching funds required by the City; and
WHEREAS, The SFFD proposes to maximize the use of the grant funds on program
expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it
RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the SFFD to accept and expend

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

grant funds in the amount of \$1,000,000 from the State of California; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of the SFFD is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, deliver, and perform, in the name of the City and County of San Francisco, all applications, contracts, agreements, amendments, and payment requests necessary to secure the State funds and implement and carry out the purposes specified in the State budget.
