2 **Resolution declaring the results of the November 5, 2002 Consolidated General**
3 **Election.**

4 WHEREAS, A Consolidated General Election was conducted in the City and County of
5 San Francisco on Tuesday, November 5, 2002, which placed before the electorate:
6 candidates for election to the San Francisco Board of Supervisors, the Governing Board of the
7 San Francisco Unified School District, the Governing Board of the San Francisco Community
8 College District, San Francisco Assessor-Recorder, Superior Court Judge, and the Governing
9 Board of the Bay Area Rapid Transit District; nineteen City and County ballot measures; and
10 one Bay Area Rapid Transit District ballot measure; and,

11 WHEREAS, John Arntz, the Acting Director of Elections of the City and County of San
12 Francisco, has certified to this Board of Supervisors the results of the Consolidated General
13 Election, a copy of which is contained in file 021972 of the Board of Supervisors,
