RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the parking of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME - RESCIND

South Van Ness Avenue, east side, from 92 to 122 feet south of Market Street.

TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING, 4 PM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY - RESCIND

Bush Street, south side, from Grant Avenue to 130 feet westerly.

TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME - ESTABLISH

Ellsworth Street, both sides, between 70 and 100 feet south of the south property line of 755 Ellsworth Street.

PERPENDICULAR (90-DEGREE ANGLE) PARKING - RESCIND

Sanchez Street, east side, from 17th Street to 91 feet northerly.

2-HOUR TIME-LIMIT, 7 AM TO 6 PM, EXCEPT SATURDAY AND SUNDAY - ESTABLISH

Kansas Street, both sides, between 15th and 16th Streets (200 block).

TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME - ESTABLISH

Oak Street, south side, from Octavia Boulevard to 56 feet westerly (existing conditions).

RED (NO PARKING ANYTIME) ZONES - ESTABLISH

Hampshire Street, west side, from 26th Street to 15 feet northerly.

UNMETERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING - ESTABLISH

2718 Bryant Street, west side, between the driveways for #2718 - 2722 and 2724 - 2726 Bryant Street, (12-foot section of curb between the driveways for these addresses, accommodating two motorcycle parking spaces).

NO PARKING ANYTIME - EXTEND

Ocean Avenue, south side, from 100 feet to 142 feet west of San Leandro Way (extends the "No Parking Anytime" regulation by 42 feet, eliminating parking meters # 591-24130).

Categorically exempt from Environmental Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and parking regulations where such changes do not establish a higher speed limit or result in more than a negligible increase in the use of the street.
