2 MOTION AMENDING RULE 6.21 OF THE RULES OF ORDER OF THE BOARD OF
3 SUPERVISORS CONCERNING THE LEGISLATIVE ANALYST.

5 WHEREAS, The legislation of the Board of Supervisors is facilitated by timely
6 information, research, data gathering and analysis provided by the Legislative Analyst ; and

7 WHEREAS, The Legislative Analyst can best serve the needs of the Board of
8 Supervisors with a clearly defined mission and mandate; and

9 WHEREAS, Certain policies and procedures need to be established to implement the
10 mission of the Legislative Analyst; now, therefore, be it

11 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby amends its Rules of Order by
12 amending Rule 6.21 to read as follows:

13 Rule 6.21 Legislative Analysts.

14 The Clerk of the Board, after hearing the recommendations of officials specified in the
15 Annual Salary Ordinance, shall appoint one or more Legislative Analysts, in appropriate
16 classifications, who, within their time resources as determined by the Clerk of the Board, shall
17 do the following:

- 18 1. Respond to requests from individual Supervisors or the Clerk of the Board
19 including, but not limited to: research, analysis, data gathering, advice,
20 consultation and other assistance relating to the official duties of Supervisors or
21 the Clerk of the Board. Individual Supervisors may request that the assistance
22 of the Legislative Analyst regarding a particular matter be confidential. Any
23 assistance concerning introduced legislation may only be by request of the
24 Board of Supervisors as a whole.
