## OAA History [Renewal Focus]


CE OF ECONOMIC &

- January 2011: Ocean Avenue Association (OAA) commences services.
- January 2021: OAA Strategic Plan Finalized (*Recommended and funded by OEWD*)
  - Designed to provide a roadmap to fix systemic and structural issues in preparation for 2025 renewal | Though this plan spurred some corrective action from OAA, progress was slow.
- **June 2021 2022:** Based on slow progress and constituent concerns with organization's compliance with their management (and at the request of Supervisor Melgar) OEWD planned to utilize budget to have Office of the Controller audit the organization in FY 22–23.
- **June 2023:** Report released finding Controller's Office produced 19 recommendations for OEWD to ensure OAA improved its control environment.
- July 2024: Per report-out from OEWD, Controller's Office confirmed close-out of 19 recommendations.
- **June 2024 Current:** Ongoing outreach throughout the corridor around renewal including survey deployment, OAA-hosted open houses, merchant mixers and door-to-

# **Renewal Process**

- 30% threshold reached in March 2025
- Resolution of Intention submitted and goes through legislative process [*authorizes the special balloting procedure*] [*Current Phase*]
- Ballots go out to ratepayers [*May 23, 2025*]
- Special ballot procedure ends [July 8, 2025]
- Services commence [1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2026]
