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10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

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12 Section 1. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding Section 10.100-338,
13 to read as follows:

14 **SEC. 10.100-338. STREET TREE MAINTENANCE FUND.**

15 *(a) Establishment of Fund. The Street Tree Maintenance Fund (“the Fund”) is hereby*
16 *established as a category three fund to receive any monies appropriated or donated for the purpose of*
17 *Maintenance, Planting, and Removal of Street Trees, as those terms are defined in Public Works Code*
18 *Section 802.*

19 *(b) Administration and Use of Funds. The Department of Public Works (“Department”) shall*
20 *administer this Fund, and may consult with the Urban Forestry Council and other City bodies and*
21 *departments on potential uses of monies in the Fund. Monies in the Fund shall only be used for the*
22 *following purposes:*

23 (1) Maintenance, Planting, and Removal of Street Trees;

24 (2) Necessary costs of administering the Fund; and

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1 (3) Legal expenses to investigate, defend, or settle any claims associated with Street
2 Tree Maintenance, Planting, or Removal.

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4 Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
5 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
6 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
7 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

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9 Section 3. Undertaking for the General Welfare. In enacting and implementing this
10 ordinance, the City is assuming an undertaking only to promote the general welfare. It is not
11 assuming, nor is it imposing on its officers and employees, an obligation for breach of which it
12 is liable in money damages to any person who claims that such breach proximately caused
13 injury.
