RESOLUTION NO. 362-99

1 [Potrero Power Plant Citizens Advisory Task Force]  
2 CREATING A POTRERO POWER PLANT CITIZENS ADVISORY TASK FORCE TO  
3 PROVIDE INPUT TO THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO REGARDING THE  
4 SALE, OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE POTRERO POWER PLANT AND TO  
5 COMPLETE ITS WORK BY DECEMBER 31, 2000.

6 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco reached an  
7 agreement with PG&E that the Hunters Point Power Plant will be  
8 closed, and the Potrero Power Plant will be closed, and the Potrero  
9 Power Plant will be sold; and

10 WHEREAS, The sale of the Potrero Power Plant may result in  
11 construction projects on the Potrero site, may entail operating the  
12 facility at higher output levels, thus creating more harmful  
13 emissions and generating additional adverse impacts on the  
14 neighborhood such as higher noise levels; and,

15 WHEREAS, San Francisco residents have expressed concern that  
16 the closure of the Bayview Power Plant and sale of the Potrero Power  
17 Plant is likely to result in the Potrero Power Plant operating at a  
18 higher capacity, and thereby emitting higher levels of pollution and  
19 noise than earlier; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County  
21 of San Francisco establishes a Potrero Power Plant Citizens Advisory  
22 Task Force consisting of thirteen (13) members who will represent  
23 the following officials and groups: the Mayor of San Francisco or  
24 his designee, a member of the Board of Supervisors, the head of the  
25 Department of Health or his designee, the head of the San Francisco

Supervisor, Yee, Ammiano

Labor Council or his designee, a representative of the Southeast Alliance for Environmental Justice, a representative of the Southeast Alliance for Environmental Justice, a representative of the Public Utilities Commission, and 7 residents of the Potrero Hill and Lower Potrero Hill neighborhood; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Potrero Power Plant Citizens Advisory Task Force shall provide the City with input on 1) issues which adversely affect the surrounding neighborhood such as noise, construction, and harmful emissions, 2) power plant workers' safety issues, and 3) any other issues deemed appropriate by the Task Force; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests the City Administrator's Office to provide staff support for the Task Force; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appointment of members to the Task Force on Potrero Hill Power Plant shall automatically expire on December 31, 2000.




