

1 [Appointment, Food Security Task Force - Michelle Kim]

3 **Motion appointing Michelle Kim (residency requirement waived), for an indefinite term,**  
4 **to the Food Security Task Force.**

6 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does  
7 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Food Security  
8 Task Force, pursuant to the provisions of Health Code, Sections 470.1 and 470.2, for the  
9 terms specified:

10 Michelle Kim (residency requirement waived), seat 12, succeeding Heather Tufts, must  
11 be from the Department of Children, Youth and their Families, for an indefinite term.; and, be it

12 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 13 1. The membership of the Food Security Task Force has a goal to be representative of  
14 the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 15 2. Applicant Michelle Kim, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with  
16 experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Food Security Task Force.
- 17 3. The Food Security Task Force has attempted to fill the position, for which Michelle  
18 Kim was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the  
19 specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this  
20 time. The Rules Committee has certified that Michelle Kim is qualified to serve on  
21 the Food Security Task Force.
- 22 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no  
23 other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco, and who has the  
24 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is  
25 willing to serve on the Food Security Task Force at this time; and, be it

1           FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement  
2 for Michelle Kim, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident(s), willing to serve, can  
3 be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(a)(2), that requires person(s) appointed to  
4 boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of  
5 Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
