Dear Board of Supervisors:

The Tenderloin Museum (TLM) is seeking a type 64 License to serve alcohol at 835 Larkin St., the TLM Annex space that serves as a venue for *The Compton's Cafeteria Riot*. This immersive play is a major, multi-year programmatic venture by TLM that brings to life a seminal moment in the neighborhood's history with a LGBTQ+ majority cast & crew of 15+ via twice-weekly shows and occasional special events/performances. The show celebrated one year of performances in April 2026, and TLM intends for it to run in perpetuity, a living memorial to our history. A purpose-built venue, this theater space is set up to be a 1950s style cafeteria, and in addition to the *Compton's* play, it has played host to regular, transgender-centric community gatherings, drag brunches, and activations for the neighborhood's long-running SF First Thursday Art Walk. TLM believes a license to serve alcohol would fulfill "public convenience or necessity" by empowering this community theater space to better support itself financially, concentrate attraction to this unique and innovative business on a hard-hit but beloved commercial corridor, and to provide a higher quality and safer experience for our guests.

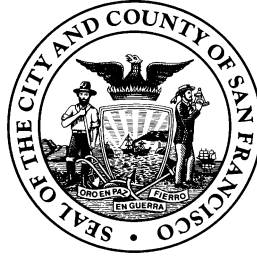
