WHEREAS, Several of San Francisco Public Library Branches have yet to be upgraded to provide such access, thereby limiting the department's ability to equalize service throughout the system; and,

WHEREAS, There is a need for a public training facility in the Main library to provide a venue for teaching members of the community how to successfully use the new technology; and,

WHEREAS, The Gates Library Initiative will provide computer workstations, software, printers and server to fulfill this need for expanded public access facilities in the Public Libraries; and,

WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget, as all funds are to be used to purchase the equipment and software; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Public Library be authorized to accept retroactively and expend \$262,900 from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation to purchase computer equipment for 15 neighborhood branch libraries and the main library.
