

1 [Study of HIV transmission behavior in HIV-positive men.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), to enter**
4 **retroactively into an agreement in the amount of \$21,786 with the University of**
5 **California, San Francisco (UCSF), the primary contractor, to participate in a study to**
6 **examine decisions to have high transmission-risk sex; study the efficacy of a**
7 **prevention counseling intervention; and determine whether future episodes of**
8 **unprotected sex is reduced, for the period of September 1, 2005 to August 31, 2006.**

10 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the National Institutes of
11 Health (NIH) for the conduct of a program titled “Changing HIV Transmission Behavior in HIV-
12 Positive Men”; and,

13 WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interest of NIH, UCSF, and DPH to participate
14 in this project; and,

15 WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse DPH in the amount of \$21,786 under the
16 terms of this agreement; and,

17 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires DPH to enter into a
18 subcontract (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
19 Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
20 resolution as if set forth fully within; and,

21 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds
22 may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually
23 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
24 of grant funding; and,

1 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because the final
2 agreement was not obtained by DPH until August 17, 2006; and,

3 WHEREAS, The contract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$2,334; now
4 therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract
6 agreement in the amount of \$21,786 with UCSF, the primary contractor, for services under the
7 program entitled "Changing HIV Transmission Behavior in HIV-Positive Men"; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
9 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions
11 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
12 the agreement expires.
