Program Construction Management (CM) Services

The Contract Monitoring Division ("CMD") has reviewed the score sheets submitted by the panelists as well as the fee proposals submitted by the Proposers. Based on the final score tabulations submitted by the SFPUC, the final rankings are listed below:

Parsons Water & Infrastructure Group, Inc., ("Parsons") is the highest ranked proposer. Additionally, Parsons complied with CMD Chapter 14B pre-award requirements. The LBE subconsultant/subcontractor requirement for this project is 20%, for Phase I of this RFP/contract. The LBE subconsultant/subcontractor requirement must be met by the cumulative participation by LBEs in Phase I of this contract: Labor Services.

Once the scope of services are identified by the SFPUC, the CMD will set an LBE subconsultant/subcontractor participation requirement for Phase II of this contract. Proposers were required to submit the Certificate of Commitment, along with CMD Form 2A (CMD Contract Participation Form), committing to the LBE subconsultant/subcontractor requirement due to be set for Phase II, once scope of services for Phase II are identified.
