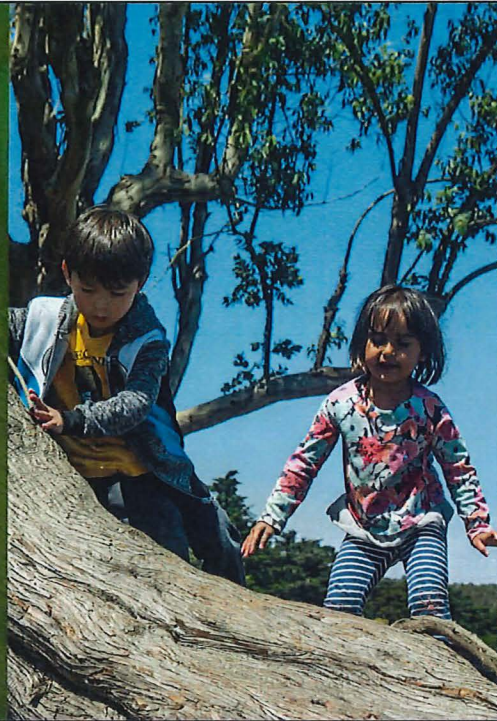

- **4,113** acres of park land
- **3,400** acres within San Francisco
- **671** marina slips
- **222** neighborhood parks
- **181** playgrounds and play areas
- **151** tennis and **72** basketball courts
- **82** recreation centers and clubhouses
- **59** soccer/playfields
- **40** community gardens
- **34** off-leash dog play areas
- **9** swimming pools
- **6** golf courses
- **2** stadiums

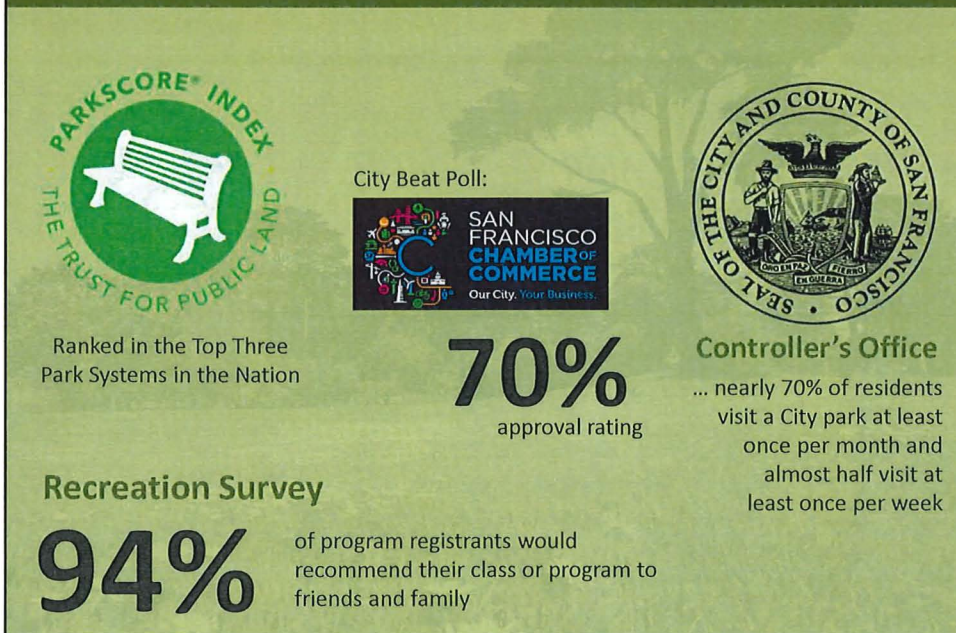

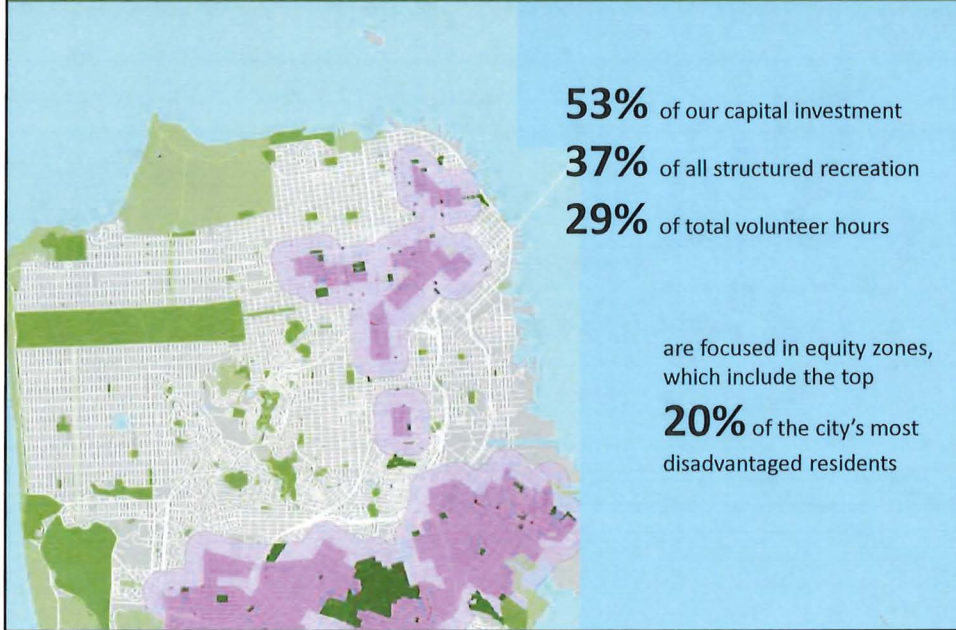
