4 **Resolution honoring Alan Heineman and declaring October 25, 2005 as “Alan**  
5 **Heineman Day” in the City and County of San Francisco.**

7 WHEREAS, Alan Heineman served as an executive officer of the University of San  
8 Francisco Faculty Association, AFT 4269, AFL-CIO, from 1976 to 1988 and President of the  
9 USF Faculty Association from 1988 to 2005; and,

10 WHEREAS, He has effectively represented the rights and interests of the faculty and  
11 librarians at the University of San Francisco while at the same time developing and fostering  
12 amicable labor-management relations at the University; and,

13 WHEREAS, He has successfully cultivated a new generation of Union leadership  
14 among the faculty and librarians and passed the mantle of leadership to that new generation;  
15 and,

16 WHEREAS, For all of these accomplishments he has earned the gratitude of more  
17 than 300 colleagues and 75 emeritus faculty; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby honor Alan Heineman for his  
19 30 years of service to the University of San Francisco Faculty Association; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors proclaim October 25, 2005 as  
21 “Alan Heineman Day” in the City and County of San Francisco.
