| 11 | Section 1. The San Francisco Municipal Elections Code is hereby amended by adding  |
| 12 | Section 130, to read as follows:   |
| 13 | Sec. 130. EARLY VOTING IN EACH SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT.   |
| 14 | (a) Incorporation of State Law. Except as otherwise provided in the Charter or this Municipal                            |
| 15 | Elections Code, absentee voting shall be governed by the California Elections Code, Section 3000, et                     |
| 16 | <u>seq.</u>  |
| 17 | (b) Early Voting in Each Supervisorial District. Any voter using an absentee ballot may, prior                           |
| 18 | to the close of the polls on election day, vote the ballot at the Department of Elections or a satellite                 |
| 19 | location of the Department of Elections established pursuant to subsection (c) of this Section.                          |
| 20 | (c) Establishment of Satellite Locations for Early Voting. The Department of Elections shall                             |
| 21 | establish at least three satellite locations in each Supervisorial district for the purpose of early voting              |
| 22 | during the ten calendar days immediately preceding any election held in the City and County of San                       |
| 23 | Francisco. Notice and operation of the satellite locations shall be made pursuant to California                          |
| 24 | Elections Code Section 3018. The Department of Elections shall establish the same number of satellit                     |

| 3                                     | (d) Days and Hours of Operation. Each satellite location established pursuant to subsection               |
| 4                                     | (c) of this Section shall be open for the ten calendar days immediately preceding election day, from      |
| 5                                     | eight o'clock a.m. to five o'clock p.m. on weekdays and from ten o'clock a.m. to five o'clock p.m. on     |
| 6                                     | weekend days. The Department of Elections may increase, but may not reduce, the hours of operation        |
| 7                                     | for the ten days preceding election day, provided that the hours of operation for all satellite locations |
| 8                                     | are the same. On election day, each satellite location shall have the same hours of operation as other    |

| 10                                    | (e) Approval by the Elections Commission. The Director of Elections shall propose and the                 |
