
- Anticipated revenue to the City: \$15,060,000
- Timeline: July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2030
- Contractor: California Department of State Hospitals (DSH)
- Project Summary:
 - DSH administers the Felony Incompetent to Stand Trial (IST) Mental Health Diversion Program to fund mental health diversion services.
 - Contract revenue is continuing support for San Francisco's pre-trial Felony IST
 Mental Health Diversion Program to provide behavioral health treatment and
 wraparound services to meet the individual needs of Felony IST Mental Health
 Diversion clients.
 - Community services will be provided by UCSF-Citywide

Retroactivity



We are seeking retroactive authorization to approve this agreement.

- The project period for this contract began July 1, 2025, and goes through June 30, 2030.
- This contract is retroactive due to delays in finalizing the agreement with the California Department of State Hospitals.
- DPH and DSH came to the final agreement for this contract on July 9, 2025, after the pre-determined contract start date.
