At its virtual meeting on Wednesday November 30th, 2022, The San Francisco Youth Commission Executive Committee voted to support BOS File 221015 "Hearing - Secured Bike Parking in SFMTA Garages and at Transit Stations" with the following feedback and recommendations:

- 1. The Youth Commission Executive Committee understands the importance of bicycling in providing mobility and freedom to young people, many of whom do not drive.
- 2. The Youth Commission Executive Committee urges for secure bike parking to be more accessible and added in locations all throughout the city such as commercial corridors, schools, and libraries, in addition to transit stations and parking garages.
- 3. The Youth Commission Executive Committee urges for secure bike parking to be more simple to use, seamless, and integrated with existing programs such as the Clipper card.
- 4. The Youth Commission Executive Committee urges for secure bike parking to accommodate larger cargo and electric bikes that many youth and families rely on.
- 5. The Youth Commission Executive Committee urges the SFMTA to change its policy to allow bikes on the Muni Metro light rail system, especially given that Muni Metro connects the hilly terrain throughout Twin Peaks and Buena Vista Heights, and many San Francisco neighborhoods in general.
