7	San Francisco's amendment and findings to the California Building Standards		
8	Commission and the Office of the State Fire Marshal.

12	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:		
13	Section 1. Findings.		
14	(a) The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this		
15	Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public		
16	Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the		
17	Board of Supervisors in File No 081089 and is incorporated herein by		
18	reference.		
19	(b) State law authorizes a city, county, or city and county to establish more		
20	restrictive building standards reasonably necessary because of local climatic, geological or		
21	topographical conditions. Findings of the local conditions and the adopted local building		
22	standards must be filed with the California Building Standards Commission to become		
23	effective. This Board of Supervisors finds that this Ordinance is reasonably necessary		
24	because of the following local conditions:		
25			

1	(i)	Certain buildings and occupancies in San Francisco are at increased risk for		
2	earthquake-induced failure and consequent fire due to local hazardous microzones, slide			
3	areas, and local liquefaction hazards.			
4	(ii)	Certain buildings and occupancies in San Francisco are at increased of fire due		
5	to high density of buildings on very small lots, with many buildings built up to the property			
6	lines.			
7	(iii)	Additional fire protection is required due to San Francisco's high building density		
8	and crowded occupancy.			
9	Section 2. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby directed to forward San			
10	Francisco's amendment and findings to the California Building Standards Commission and to			
11	the Office of the State Fire Marshal upon final passage of this ordinance.			
12	Section 3. The San Francisco Fire Code is hereby amended by adding Section 2611,			
13	to read as follows:			
14	Sec. 2611. [For SF] HOT WORK ON ROOFS			
15	A torch-applied roof system, as defined in Section 2602 of the California Fire Code, is			
16	prohibited from being installed on a wood roof or roof made of other combustible material. A			
17	torch-applied roof system may be installed on a non-combustible roof in compliance with the			
18	requirements of Chapter 26 of the California Fire Code.
