WHEREAS, The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has agreed to fund the Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$272,000 for participation in a program, entitled "California Home Visiting Program (CHVP)," for the period of July 1, 2022, through September 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, The grant will be used to fund other additional staff costs associated with providing home visits or administration for programs, including the following staff: Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV) MIECHV-funded staff conducting home visiting (e.g., MIECHV home visitors, MIECHV home visiting supervisors who carry home visiting caseloads) and other MIECHV-funded staff (staff not directly responsible for service delivery); and

WHEREAS, DPH staff will develop a process for identifying and prioritizing target audiences, training needs, relevant topics for training of home visiting staff and/or CHVP MIECHV funded/enrolled families; and

WHEREAS, DPH staff will develop, conduct, and assess training of home visitors that are employed by the recipient in, conducting a virtual home visit; emergency preparedness and response planning for families and safely conducting intimate partner violence screenings; and

WHEREAS, Provide emergency supplies (such as diapers and diapering supplies) to CHVP MIECHV-funded/enrolled families; and

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received the award letter on April 4, 2023, for a project start date of July 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$272,000 from the CDPH; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City.
