3 **Ordinance authorizing the service of an Offer to Compromise under Code of Civil**  
4 **Procedure, Section 998, in the lawsuit filed by Penny Mims against the City and County**  
5 **of San Francisco and Dorian Carr, to include a payment from the City of up to \$50,000**  
6 **plus reasonable attorneys' fees and costs to be determined by the Court; the lawsuit**  
7 **was filed on March 3, 2020, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-20-583388;**  
8 **entitled Penny Mims v. City and County of San Francisco, Dorian Carr, et al.; the**  
9 **lawsuit involves an employment dispute.**

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11 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

12 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby  
13 authorizes the City Attorney to make an Offer to Compromise under Code of Civil Procedure  
14 Section 998 in the action entitled Penny Mims v. City and County of San Francisco, Dorian  
15 Carr, et al., San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-20-583388, by the payment of up  
16 to \$50,000, plus reasonable attorneys' fees and costs to be determined by the Court. The  
17 lawsuit involves an employment dispute.

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19 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on  
20 March 3, 2020, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Plaintiff: Penny Mims;  
21 Defendants: City and County of San Francisco, Dorian Carr.
