

1 [Approval of a 60-Day Extension for Planning Commission Review of an Ordinance (File No.
2 131120) That Would Establish the Broadway Alcohol Restricted Use District]

3 **Resolution extending by 60-days the prescribed time within which the Planning**
4 **Commission may render its decision on an Ordinance (File No. 131120) amending the**
5 **Planning Code, by adding a new Section 789, to establish the Broadway Alcohol Restricted**
6 **Use District on parcels with street frontage on Broadway, between Columbus Avenue and**
7 **Montgomery Street; amending the Zoning Map, Sheet SU-02, to designate the Broadway**
8 **Alcohol Restricted Use District; and making environmental findings, and findings of**
9 **consistency with the General Plan, and the eight priority policies of Planning Code, Section**
10 **101.1.**

11 WHEREAS, On November 19, 2013, Supervisor Chiu introduced legislation amending
12 the Planning Code, by adding a new Section 789, to establish the Broadway Alcohol
13 Restricted Use District on parcels with street frontage on Broadway, between Columbus
14 Avenue and Montgomery Street; amending the Zoning Map, Sheet SU-02, to designate the
15 Broadway Alcohol Restricted Use District; and making environmental findings, and findings of
16 consistency with the General Plan, and the eight priority policies of Planning Code, Section
17 101.1. A copy of said legislation is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File
18 No. 130999 and is incorporated herein by reference; and

19 WHEREAS, On or about November 26, 2013, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors
20 referred the proposed ordinance to the Planning Commission, which currently is reviewing the
21 proposed ordinance; and

22 WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by
23 Resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its
24 decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code that the Board of Supervisors
25 initiates; and

1 WHEREAS, Supervisor Chiu has requested additional time for the Planning
2 Commission to review the proposed Ordinance; and

3 WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the Planning
4 Commission additional time to review the proposed Ordinance and render its decision; now,
5 therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That by this Resolution, the Board hereby extends the prescribed time
7 within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on the proposed Ordinance for
8 approximately 60 additional days, until April 26, 2014.
