Professional Engineering and Other Support Services for Muni Metro Third Street Light Rail Project: New Central Subway, with the Joint Venture of Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade & Douglas, Inc. and PGH Wong Engineering, Inc., to provide necessary professional engineering and other support services in an amount not to exceed \$29,800,000, and for a term not to exceed five years; the contract shall be initially

[Consultant Contract for New Central Subway phase of Third St. Light Rail Transit Project.]

WHEREAS, The 1.75-mile New Central Subway (NCS) is Phase II of the Third Street Light Rail Project; and

certified for \$4.3 million in Traffic Congestion Relief Program funding.

WHEREAS, On November 6, 2001, the Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 01-108, which authorized the Director of Transportation to advertise a request for proposals (RFP) for Contract No. CS-138, Professional Engineering Services for Muni Metro Third Street Light Rail Project: New Central Subway, select the most qualified proposer, and negotiate a contract with that proposer to procure conceptual engineering and preliminary engineering services at a cost not to exceed \$40,000,000, and for a term not to exceed five years; and,

WHEREAS, The MTA received written proposals from the following firms: (1) Bechtel Infrastructure Corporation; (2) Central Transit Consultants, A Joint Venture of URS, Parsons & AGS; and (3) a Joint Venture of Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade and Douglas and PGH Wong Engineering; and,

WHEREAS, The team of Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade and Douglas and PGH Wong Engineering was ranked number one after the oral presentations and interviews; and.

WHEREAS, MTA received concerns that the selection process may have been unduly influenced; and,

WHEREAS, MTA decided to convene a new selection panel to review and short list the proposals and re-conduct oral interviews; and,

WHEREAS, The second selection panel evaluated the written proposals of the three proposers, elected to interview all three proposers, and rated the team of Parsons

Brinckerhoff Quade and Douglas and PGH Wong Engineering first after the oral presentations and interviews; and,

WHEREAS, MTA has negotiated a contract with Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade and Douglas and PGH Wong Engineering, a Joint Venture, to perform the full scope of work at a cost not to exceed \$29,800,000, and a term not to exceed five years; and,

WHEREAS, MTA will not authorize preliminary engineering design unless and until (1) the Federal Transit Administration grants approval to enter preliminary engineering; (2) additional funds are made available; and (3) the Consultant has satisfactorily completed conceptual engineering; and,

WHEREAS, On November 19, 2002, pursuant to Resolution No. 02-144, the MTA Board of Directors approved the award of Contract No. CS-138 to Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade and Douglas, Inc. and PGH Wong Engineering, Inc., a Joint Venture, for an amount not to exceed \$29,800,000 and a term not to exceed five years, with the Contract to be certified initially for an amount not to exceed \$4,300,000, and authorized the Director of Transportation to execute said Agreement in a form to be approved by the City Attorney's Office, pending approval by the Civil Service Commission and the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors approves the award of Contract No. CS-138, Professional Engineering and Other Support Services for Muni Metro Third Street Light

Rail Project: New Central Subway, to Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade and Douglas, Inc. and PGH Wong Engineering, Inc., a Joint Venture, for an amount not to exceed \$29,800,000 and a term not to exceed five years, subject to the approval by the Civil Service Commission, and authorizes the Director of Transportation to execute said Agreement in a form approved by the City Attorney's Office and substantially as contained in the document on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 021973, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein: and, be it

<u>FURTHER RESOLVED, That the contract shall be certified initially for the available</u> <u>amount of Traffic Congestion Relief Programs funding, which is \$4.3 million.</u>
