

1 [Contracting out Jail Food Services]

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3 **Resolution approving the Controller’s certification that food service management**
4 **operations for the the City and County of San Francisco’s Jails can practically be**
5 **performed by private contractor at a lower cost for the year commencing July 1, 2001,**
6 **than if work were performed by City and County employees.**

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8 WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed
9 Proposition J in November, 1976, allowing City departments to contract with private
10 companies for specific services which can be practically performed for a lower cost than
11 similar work by City and County employees; and

12 WHEREAS, The Controller has certified on May 1, 2001 that services involved in the
13 administration and provision of food service management operations in the City and County of
14 San Francisco’s Jails for the year commencing July 1, 2001 can be performed at a lower cost
15 to the City and County of San Francisco than if such services were performed by employees
16 of the City and County of San Francisco; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 10.104.15 of the Charter, the Board of
18 Supervisors hereby approves said Controller’s certification.

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
