VACANCY NOTICE

OFFICE OF EARLY CARE AND EDUCATION CITIZENS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of the following vacancies:

Vacant seat 6, new appointment, must be a family child care provider, for a two-year term ending May 1, 2017.

Vacant seat 7, new appointment, must be a provider of early care and education at a community-based childcare center in San Francisco, but this member cannot be a San Francisco Unified School District provider, for a three-year term ending May 1, 2018.

Vacant seat 8, new appointment, must be a family support provider, a provider or educator who works with children with special needs, a community member with expertise in early education, a member of the mental health community specializing in early care, a member of philanthropic organization, or a member of the business community with an interest in early care and education issues, for a two-year term ending May 1, 2017.

Vacant seat 9, new appointment, must be a representative of the Childcare Planning and Advisory Council and nominated to the Board of Supervisors, for a three-year term ending May 1, 2018.

Reports: The Advisory Committee shall work with the Office of Early Care and Education to develop a strategic plan and proposal, to be submitted to the Board of Supervisors no later than January 1, 2016, that addresses the expansion of quality universal early care in San Francisco.

Sunset Date: None.

The appointment(s) of the individual(s) who are recommended by the Rules Committee will be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors for final approval.
