3 AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, POPULATION HEALTH AND
4 PREVENTION, TO ACCEPT RETROACTIVELY AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS OF \$93,755.60
5 FROM THE CALIFORNIA HEALTH FOUNDATION AND TRUST TO DEVELOP TELEHEALTH
6 CAPACITY FOR AFRICAN AMERICANS LIVING IN SAN FRANCISCO AND TO ENTER INTO AN
7 AGREEMENT WHICH INCLUDES RIGHTS IN DATA, INDEMNIFICATION, AND BINDING
8 ARBITRATION CLAUSES AND WHICH DOES NOT INCLUDE INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY
9 INDEMNIFICATION AND FALSE CLAIMS CLAUSES.

10 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health has applied for and been awarded a grant from
11 The California Health Foundation and Trust in the amount of \$93,755.60 to develop telehealth capacity
12 for African Americans living in San Francisco; and,

13 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, The California Health Foundation
14 and Trust requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file
15 with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 001196 ; and

16 WHEREAS, The Agreement contains certain provisions described below, which require the
17 approval of the Board of Supervisors; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Agreement does not contain certain provisions described below, which are
19 required under the Administrative Code unless waived by the Board of Supervisors; and,

20 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$8,664; now, therefore,
21 be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to accept retroactively
23 and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement
25 on behalf of the City; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the provision in the
2 Agreement pursuant to which the City agrees to grant a royalty-free and nonexclusive license for the
3 use of data developed under the Agreement; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the provision in the
5 Agreement pursuant to which the City indemnifies the The California Health Foundation and Trust;
6 and, be it


7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the provision in the
8 Agreement pursuant to which the City agrees to submit all claims arising out of the Agreement to
9 binding arbitration; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement
11 contained in Section 21.21 of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include an indemnification
12 of the City by The California Health Foundation and Trust for the infringement of patent rights,
13 copyright, trademark, and other intellectual property rights; and, be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement that the
15 Agreement include a paragraph reciting the false claims provisions contained in Section 21.35 of the
16 Administrative Code: and, be it


17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Department of Public

19 recurs or is renewed.




