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4	Resolution urging the California State University system to develop uniform hiring
5	policies to ensure workforce diversity.
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7	WHEREAS, The Bureau of State Audits recently found that the California State
8	University (CSU) system lacks a uniform hiring policy for professors and managers; and,
9	WHEREAS, The lack of a uniform policy has resulted in search committees that do not
10	include women or minority members and has hampered CSU's efforts to create a diverse
11	workforce; and,
12	WHEREAS, The lack of diversity has resulted in a workforce that does not represent
13	California's diverse population, decreasing the quality of education provided at CSU; and,
14	WHEREAS, This has resulted in discrimination against minorities in the hiring process
15	and has left CSU exposed to unnecessary legal action; and,
16	WHEREAS, Since 2002, 92 employment discrimination charges have been filed
17	against CSU, costing the state more than \$7.6 million in damages and attorney fees; and,
18	WHEREAS, The University of California has developed uniform hiring policies which
19	have helped create a diverse workforce campus-wide; now, therefore, be it
20	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
21	urges the California State University system to develop a comprehensive uniform hiring policy
22	to be implemented system wide; and, be it
23	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the California State
24	University system to require that all search committees for professors and administrative staff
25	include women and minorities; and, be it

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board
2	to send a copy of this resolution to the Chancellor and Board of Trustees of the California
3	State University System.
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
