

1 [Software License and Support Agreement - JobAps, Inc. - Software Support Services - Not to  
2 Exceed \$2,237,020]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Controller to enter into the tenth amendment of a software**  
4 **license and support agreement with JobAps, Inc., increasing the contract term of**  
5 **November 27, 2006, through November 26, 2016, by two years through November 26,**  
6 **2018, and increasing the maximum expenditure by \$612,350 to an amount not to**  
7 **exceed \$2,237,020.**

9 WHEREAS, On November 27, 2006, the City and County of San Francisco ("City"),  
10 acting through its Controller, entered into an Agreement with JobAps, Inc. ("JobAps"), for a  
11 hosted application for web-based job application recruitment, testing, certification and referral  
12 services ("Agreement"); and

13 WHEREAS, The initial term of this Agreement was for three years, with two options to  
14 extend at the City's option for a period of two years, and the initial maximum expenditure was  
15 \$250,000; and

16 WHEREAS, The Controller and JobAps amended the Agreement by the First  
17 Amendment, dated January 20, 2009; Second Amendment, dated December 1, 2009; Third  
18 Amendment, dated January 3, 2011; Fourth Amendment, dated August 1, 2011; Fifth  
19 Amendment, dated January 1, 2012; Sixth Amendment, dated August 7, 2012; Seventh  
20 Amendment, dated January 1, 2013; Eighth Amendment, dated November 1, 2013; and Ninth  
21 Amendment, dated December 1, 2014, extending the term to November 26, 2016, and  
22 increasing the maximum expenditure to \$1,624,670; and

23 WHEREAS, By the Tenth Amendment the Controller and JobAps have agreed to  
24 extend the term to November 26, 2018, and increase the maximum expenditure by \$612,350  
25 to \$2,237,020 for continued software support services; and

1           WHEREAS, The Controller has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to  
2 extend the term of the Agreement beyond ten years and increase the maximum expenditure  
3 to \$2,237,020, so that the City may continue to receive software support services; and

4           WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b), "Contract and Lease Limitations," requires  
5 Board of Supervisors' approval of any contract having a term in excess of ten years or  
6 requiring anticipated expenditures by the City of \$10,000,000; and

7           WHEREAS, The Tenth Amendment is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors  
8 in File No. 160956, which is hereby declared to be a part of this motion as if set forth fully  
9 herein; now, therefore, be it

10          RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the Tenth Amendment to the  
11 Agreement with JobAps; and, be it

12          FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon execution of the Tenth Amendment, the Controller  
13 shall transmit to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a copy of the Tenth Amendment, for  
14 inclusion in File No. 160956.
