

[Recreation and Park Department – Coit Tower Non-Resident Fees]

Ordinance amending the San Francisco Park Code, Article 12, by amending Section 12.06, to establish non-San Francisco Resident fees for the elevator at Coit Tower, and making environmental findings.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Findings.

The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____ and is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by amending Section 12.06, to read as follows:

SEC. 12.06. COIT TOWER.

(a) The following fees shall be charged for admission to Coit Tower:

Age/Category	Admission Fee	<u>Elevator Fee</u> <u>Non-San Francisco Residents</u>
Adult	\$5.00	<u>\$7.00</u>
Senior (65+)	\$3.00	<u>\$5.00</u>
Youth (12 – 17 years)	\$3.00	<u>\$5.00</u>

1	Child (5 – 11 years)	\$1.50	<u>\$2.00</u>
2	Child (4 years and under)	\$0.00	<u>\$0.00</u>

4 (b) Audio tours: Upon development, and approval by the Commission, of an audio tour
5 for Coit Tower, the entrance fee for the facility shall be increased by \$1.00 to cover the cost of
6 rental of the tour. The rental fee for the audio tour without admission to the rest of the facility
7 will be \$3.00.
