RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco commend the New England Journal of Medicine for enhancing the medical services African Americans, women and racial minorities, in general, will receive in the future by publishing such report; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the heath care providers of the City and County of San Francisco to be more sensitive in treating African American, women, in particular, and patients of color, in particular.
