WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City and County of San Francisco to encourage it's children to read and appreciate literature; and

WHEREAS, (the Juvenile Probation Department and the Unified School District do not currently provide a library program for youth detained at Juvenile Hall or Log Cabin Ranch; and;

WHEREAS, the Volunteer Auxiliary of Youth Guidance Center is graciously offering a donation of \$12,500 to the Juvenile Probation Department to fund, in part, a first year library program in Juvenile Hall and Log Cabin Ranch; and

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Public Library is offering to match the Auxiliary gift with \$9,750 and the Juvenile Probation Department is offering to match the gift with \$25,000, to fund the total program cost of \$47,250: and

WHEREAS the San Francisco Public Library will have to create one additional limited-tenure Librarian 1, at a total cost of \$47,250 for salary and fringe benefits, to administer this new library program; and

WHEREAS, the \$12,500 gift from the Volunteer Auxiliary of Youth Guidance Center will fund direct program costs and not indirect costs, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department be authorized to accept \$12,500 from the Volunteer Auxiliary of Youth Guidance Center as part of the total funding needed to start a library program in Juvenile Hall and Log Cabin Ranch; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Public Library be authorized to hire one temporary librarian for the nine month period starting October 1, 2000.
