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3 **Resolution commending the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission for its**  
4 **outstanding performance and receiving awards for leadership in wastewater treatment**  
5 **and renewable energy resources.**  
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7 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) received the  
8 United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) 2004 National Clean Water Action  
9 Award for industry leadership in wastewater treatment in recognition of the SFPUC's  
10 Oceanside Wastewater Treatment Plant for demonstrating outstanding technological  
11 achievements in their wastewater treatment and pollution abatement program; and

12 WHEREAS, The SFPUC is one of more than 16,000 publicly-owned and 60,000  
13 industrially-owned wastewater treatment plants in the United States (by treating and  
14 discharging in excess of 84 million gallons per day to the Bay and Pacific Ocean) the National  
15 Clean Water Act Recognition Award is a significant achievement highlighting San Francisco's  
16 commitment to exceed the minimum requirements needed to meet federal and state  
17 discharge guidelines; and

18 WHEREAS, The SFPUC received a Green Power Leadership Award, sponsored by the  
19 EPA and United States Department of Energy (DOE) at the National Green Power Marketing  
20 Conference in Albany, New York, in recognition for being a nationwide leader in renewable  
21 energy by its installation of a 675-kilowatt solar system atop the Moscone West Convention  
22 Center; and

23 WHEREAS, The electricity generated by Moscone's solar system, combined with  
24 saving from energy efficiency measure, delivers the equivalent energy to power approximately

1 8,500 homes, the Green Power Leadership Award have recognized the Moscone project as a  
2 national model for obtaining municipal energy for pollution-free sources; now, therefore, be it
