Resolution commending the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission for its outstanding performance and receiving awards for leadership in wastewater treatment and renewable energy resources.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) received the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) 2004 National Clean Water Action Award for industry leadership in wastewater treatment in recognition of the SFPUC's Oceanside Wastewater Treatment Plant for demonstrating outstanding technological achievements in their wastewater treatment and pollution abatement program; and

WHEREAS, The SFPUC is one of more than 16,000 publicly-owned and 60,000 industrially-owned wastewater treatment plants in the United States (by treating and discharging in excess of 84 million gallons per day to the Bay and Pacific Ocean) the National Clean Water Act Recognition Award is a significant achievement highlighting San Francisco's commitment to exceed the minimum requirements needed to meet federal and state discharge guidelines; and

WHEREAS, The SFPUC received a Green Power Leadership Award, sponsored by the EPA and United States Department of Energy (DOE) at the National Green Power Marketing Conference in Albany, New York, in recognition for being a nationwide leader in renewable energy by its installation of a 675-kilowatt solar system atop the Moscone West Convention Center; and

WHEREAS, The electricity generated by Moscone's solar system, combined with saving from energy efficiency measure, delivers the equivalent energy to power approximately

8,500 homes, the Green Power Leadership Award have recognized the Moscone project as a national model for obtaining municipal energy for pollution-free sources; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED; That San Francisco Board or Supervisors commends the SFPUC for receiving awards for leadership in wastewater treatment and renewable energy resources.
