3 **Resolution authorizing adoption of the San Francisco County Plan for the Substance**
4 **Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000 and the Substance Abuse Offender Treatment**
5 **Program for Fiscal Year 2008-2009.**

7 WHEREAS, The voters of the State of California passed Proposition 36: The
8 Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000; and,

9 WHEREAS, Proposition 36 requires certain non-violent drug possession offenders to
10 receive substance abuse treatment in the community rather than be incarcerated; and,

11 WHEREAS, Proposition 36 services began on July 1, 2001; and,

12 WHEREAS, The State of California established the Substance Abuse Offender
13 Treatment Program in Fiscal Year 2006-2007 to enhance Proposition 36 outcomes and
14 accountability; and,

15 WHEREAS, The County is required to adopt a County Plan for the Substance Abuse
16 and Crime Prevention Act of 2000 and the Substance Abuse Offender Treatment Program for
17 Fiscal Year 2008-2009; and,

18 WHEREAS, The County Plan proposed by the San Francisco Department of Public
19 Health is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 081265, which is hereby
20 declared to be a part of the Resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the San Francisco
22 County Plan for the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000 and the Substance
23 Abuse Offender Treatment Program for Fiscal Year 2008-2009; and, be it

2 Francisco shall comply with the provisions of the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act
3 of 2000 and the California Code of Regulations, Division 4, Chapter 2.5; and, be it

5 Francisco shall comply with the provisions of the Substance Abuse Offender Treatment
6 Program and California Health and Safety Code Division 10.10, Chapter 75, Statutes of 2006
7 (Assembly Bill 1808).
