Resolution approving a Second Amendment to the agreement between the Department of Public Health and the Tides Center to provide supportive housing property management services at Direct Access to Housing sites under the Delivering Innovation in Supportive Housing Program, to extend the term by five years and increase the contract by \$23,136,504, for a total of \$40,508,317 for the period of July 1, 2008, through June 30, 2018.

WHEREAS, As part of the City's efforts to end homelessness in San Francisco, the Department of Public Health's Housing and Urban Health (DPH HUH) section oversees the provision of property management and support services for the Direct Access to Housing (DAH) Program to provide permanent, service-enriched housing to people who are homeless, enabling them to remain housed while improving their health outcomes, overall well-being, and integration into the community; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health conducted a Request for Proposals in 2007 which resulted in the selection of the Tides Center to provide supportive housing property management services at Direct Access to Housing (DAH) sites under the Delivering Innovation in Supportive Housing (DISH) program, services which include rent collection, lease management, tenant move-in/move-out, repairs, maintenance, 24-hour front desk coverage and janitorial services in storage and office areas, as well as the Housing and Urban Health Clinic; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health established an agreement with the Tides Center for those services in 2008/09; and

WHEREAS, A first amendment to the agreement was approved by the Board of Supervisors by Resolution 388-10, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 100929, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health desires to establish a second amendment to the agreement to extend the term of the agreement by five years, from July 1; 2008, through June 30, 2013, to July 1, 2008, through June 30, 2018, and to increase the contract by \$23,136,504, from \$17,371,813 to \$40,508,317; and

WHEREAS, A copy of this second amendment is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 121212, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, This amendment requires Board approval under Section 9.118 of the San Francisco Administrative Code; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Public Health and the Purchaser, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, to execute an amendment to the contract with the Tides Center to extend the term from July 1, 2008, through June 30, 2013, to July 1, 2008, through June 30, 2018, and to increase the contract by \$23,136,504, from \$17,371,813 to \$40,508,317; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Public Health and the Office of Contract Administration/Purchaser to make amendments to this contract, as needed.
