

1 [Apply for Grants - California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery
2 Funds]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of the Environment to submit**
4 **applications for a used oil recycling competitive grant, and all grants offered by**
5 **California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, for the purpose**
6 **of advancing zero waste, and safely managing and reducing household**
7 **hazardous waste and used motor oil.**

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9 WHEREAS, Public Resources Code, Sections 40000 et.seq., authorize the
10 California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to
11 administer various grant programs in furtherance of the State of California's efforts to
12 reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste, thereby preserving landfill capacity and
13 protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

14 WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering grant programs require
15 an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related
16 to the administration of the grant; now, therefore be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of
18 the Department of the Environment, or a designee, to apply for all available
19 CalRecycle grants; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the
21 Director of the Department of Environment, or a designee, to execute in the name of
22 the City and County of San Francisco all documents, including but not limited to,
23 applications, contracts, payment requests, agreements, annual reports (including
24 expenditure reports) and amendments hereto for the purposes of securing grant

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funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the program application; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That, to meet CalRecycle's requirement that San Francisco's governing body approve the submission of funding applications, the Board of Supervisors authorizes the submission of an application to CalRecycle for all available grants and payments, and this authorization shall remain in effect for five years from February 15, 2014.
