

1 [Sewer Emergency]

2 **APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE EMERGENCY WORK TO**  
3 **REPLACE THE STRUCTURALLY INADEQUATE SEWER ON POLK STREET FROM**  
4 **WASHINGTON STREET TO CLAY STREET.**

5 **WHEREAS**, On May 14, 1999, PUC Sewer Operations identified an emergency sewer condition  
6 on Polk Street from Washington Street to Clay Street; and

7 **WHEREAS**, The existing sewer at the Polk Street and Washington Street intersection had been  
8 damaged by a broken water main, and the rest of the sewer on Polk Street from Washington Street to  
9 Clay Street was also structurally inadequate; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Immediate repairs were required in order to protect the health, welfare, and property  
11 of the Citizens of San Francisco; and

12 **WHEREAS**, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specifications for Contract  
13 No. CW-242E, "Polk Street Emergency Sewer Replacement" to slipline the existing 3' x 5' brick sewer  
14 with 325 feet of 16-inch diameter polyethylene pipe (PEP); and

15 **WHEREAS**, The Contractor, A. Ruiz Construction, began the emergency work on May 24, 1999  
16 and completed it on June 7, 1999; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Because this was an emergency contract, HRC subcontracting goals were not  
18 established by the HRC Contract Compliance Officer assigned to monitor the Clean Water Program's  
19 sewer replacement program; however, the Contract was awarded to an LBE/MBE contractor; and

20 **WHEREAS**, The cost of the project is projected to be \$120,366, of which \$93,216 is for the  
21 construction contract. Funds are available from the Repair and Replacement Fund (Fund 5C/CPF/R&R,  
22 FAMIS Project No. CENRNR032, Job Order No. 1801N), and \$14,210 will be reimbursed by the Water  
23 Department for the work at the Polk Street and Washington Street intersection; and

24 **WHEREAS**, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section 6.30  
25 of the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an

1 emergency; now, therefore, be it

2       **RESOLVED**, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds for the  
3 emergency work to replace the structurally inadequate sewer on Polk Street from Washington Street to  
4 Clay Street.




