8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to
 9 continue a certain project designated the Special Emphasis Victim
 10 Assistance Program - Surviving Families of Homicide Victims to be
 11 funded in part from funds made available through the Victims of Crime
 12 Act (VOCA), Public Law 98-473, as amended, administered by the
 13 California Office of Criminal Justice Planning ("OCJP"); and,

14 WHEREAS, this project provides assistance to families of
 15 homicide victims in the City and County of San Francisco; now,
 16 therefore, be it

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17 RESOLVED, That the District Attorney of the City and County of
 18 San Francisco is authorized, retroactively, on behalf of the City and
 19 County of San Francisco to accept and expend \$110,000 of ~~continued~~ funding for
 20 this project from OCJP, and waiving indirect costs due to funding
 21 constraints, and be it

 23 execute on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the applicant agrees to provide all in-
4 kind or cash match contributions required for said project (including
5 any amendments thereof) under the program and funding terms and
6 conditions of OCJP; and be it


7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the
8 performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court
9 actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant
10 recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and
11 OCJP disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not
13 be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

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
