

1 [Support and enhance podiatry, nutrition, and diabetic nurse educator services at the Potrero
2 Hill Health Center.]

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4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
5 **accept and expend retroactively a new grant in the amount of \$75,000 from the**
6 **Franklin Benevolent Corporation (FBC) to expand on-site direct patient care services**
7 **for vulnerable and high-risk patients at the Potrero Hill Health Center and to enter into**
8 **an agreement for the use of these funds; for the period of July 1, 2002 through June 30,**
9 **2003.**

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11 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant from FBC in the
12 amount of \$75,000 to expand on-site direct patient care services for vulnerable and high-risk
13 patients at the Potrero Hill Health Center; and,

14 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, FBC requires the City to enter
15 into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
16 Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
17 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on
19 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs
21 in the grant budget; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend
23 retroactively a grant in the amount of \$75,000 from FBC; and, be it

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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the
2 grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to San
3 Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
5 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions
7 funded under this agreement as. "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
8 the agreement expires.
