[Liquor License Transfer - 1552 Polk Street]

Resolution considering that the transfer of a Type 20 off-sale beer and wine license from 5621 Geary Boulevard to 1552 Polk Street (District 3), to Frank Slacik for Blue Fog Markets, LLC, dba the Blue Fog Market, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4, and recommending that the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.

WHEREAS, Frank Slacik is seeking the transfer of a Type 20 off-sale beer and wine license from 5621 Geary Boulevard to 1552 Polk Street for Blue Fog Markets, LLC, dba the Blue Fog Market; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned and recommends approval; and,

WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero (0) protests and one (1) letter of support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license; and

WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the following: 1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. daily; 2) No more than 15% of the square footage of the premises will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages; 3) Loitering (defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the

licensee as depicted on the ABC-257; 4) The sale of beer or malt beverages in quantities of 22 oz., 24 oz., 40 oz., or similar size containers is prohibited, except for microbrews, craft brews, organic and specialty malt products sold under such designations as stout, porter, IPA and ESB. This condition is intended to eliminate high alcohol, low-cost products that are frequently abused, but not prevent the sale of specialty and craft beer products; and 5) Wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 375 ml; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code. Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the transfer of a Type 20 off-sale beer and wine license from 5621 Geary Boulevard to 1552 Polk Street, to Frank Slacik for Blue Fog Markets, LLC, dba the Blue Fog Market, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police Department listed above, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the license.
