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3 **Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Applied Remedial**
4 **Technologies, Inc. against the City and County of San Francisco for eighty thousand**
5 **dollars (\$80,000); the lawsuit was filed on in the Superior Court of the City and County**
6 **of San Francisco , Case No.CGC-03-419941; entitled Applied Remedial Technologies,**

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9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to settle the action entitled "Applied
11 Remedial Technologies, Inc. v. City and County of San Francisco, et al., Superior Court of the
12 City and County of San Francisco, Court No. CGC-03-419941 by the payment of eighty
13 thousand dollars (\$80,000).

14 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in the Superior Court of the City and
15 County of San Francisco on April 30, 2003, and the following parties were named in the
16 lawsuit: a) Applied Remedial Technologies, Inc.(plaintiff and cross-defendant), the City and
17 County of San Francisco (defendant and cross-complainant), and Camp, Dresser, & McKee
18 (defendant).
