7 WHEREAS, The three-day Blues & Art on the Bay Festival held at Treasure Island on
8 September 5-7, 1998 was a success, with 60,000 visitors; and,

9 WHEREAS, Ferry and bus transportation to Treasure Island was utilized by over 1/3 of
10 the Festival attendees; and,

11 WHEREAS, Treasure Island will be open to the public every weekend through the end
12 of 1998; and,

13 WHEREAS, There are currently no plans for public transportation to Treasure Island;
14 now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
16 urges the Treasure Island Development Authority to develop plans for public transportation to
17 Treasure Island and to implement a parking fee plan which will encourage the use of public
18 transportation; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Treasure Island Development Authority
20 communicate to the Board of Supervisors its plan for implementing public transportation to
21 Treasure Island.




