6 WHEREAS, San Francisco State University will be presenting *Chang*  
7 *Dai-chien in California*, an exhibition of forty paintings and other  
8 materials by the acclaimed Chinese Artist, Chang Dai-chien, from  
9 September 26, 1999, through November 20, 1999; and,

10 WHEREAS, *Chang Dai-chien in California* is the first exhibition  
11 of Chang's work from 1967 to 1977, a period when he developed a  
12 radical "splash color and splash ink" technique inspired by abstract  
13 expressionism; and,

14 WHEREAS, *Chang Dai-chien in California* commemorates the 100<sup>th</sup>  
15 anniversary of Chang's birth and is presented as part of San  
16 Francisco State University's Centennial Celebration; and,

17 WHEREAS, Chang is the best known Chinese painter of the 20<sup>th</sup>  
18 century and is often referred to as the "Picasso of China"; and,

19 WHEREAS, *Chang Dai-chien in California* is the most important  
20 exhibit of Chang's works in the United States since the retrospective  
21 at the San Francisco Asian Art Museum in 1972 and the 1991 exhibit by  
22 the Arthur M. Sackler Gallery of the Smithsonian Institution; and,

23 WHEREAS, In honor of this historic exhibit, a special  
24 commemorative edition of the World Journal will print each of the  
25 forty artworks; now, therefore, be it


