The State of California and OCJP disclaim responsibility for such liability; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is urged to designate the 2.5 FTE positions created under the proposed grant as "G", or grant-funded positions.
