

1 [Amending Board Rule 3.11 to require the Clerk to refer to Committee continued resolutions
2 that fail to obtain the waiver of Rule 2.11 that must occur if a resolution is to be considered on
3 the adoption without committee reference portion of the Board agenda.]

4 **Motion amending Rule 3.11 of the Rules of Order of the Board of Supervisors to**
5 **provide that when a continued resolution is placed on the adoption without committee**
6 **reference portion of the Board's agenda, and the Board declines to waive Rule 2.11,**
7 **which requires the referral of all legislative matters to committee, then the Board shall**
8 **not vote on the proposed resolution, and the Clerk of the Board shall refer the**
9 **resolution to committee.**

11 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
12 hereby amends Rule 3.11 of the Rules of Order of the Board of Supervisors, to read as
13 follows:

14 **3.11. Adoption without Committee Reference Agenda.** The Board may consider
15 resolutions for immediate, unanimous, adoption without reference to committee which are
16 presented to the Clerk of the Board by a Supervisor or the Mayor at the previous week's
17 Board meeting or prior to 12:00 noon the Wednesday before a Board meeting. The President
18 shall inquire whether any Supervisors wish to discuss or object to any of the resolutions
19 presented for immediate adoption. Resolutions to which there is an objection shall be referred
20 to committee unless withdrawn by the Sponsor. The roll then shall be called on the
21 resolutions as a group. The Board may also consider motions for immediate adoption without
22 reference to committee, six yes votes being required for adoption, which are presented to the
23 Clerk of the Board by a Supervisor or the Mayor at the previous week's Board meeting or prior
24 to 12:00 noon the Wednesday before a Board meeting. If a resolution for immediate adoption
25 consideration has been continued from a previous Board meeting, it may be approved if the Board first

1 waives, by a two-thirds vote, the provisions of Rule 2.11, which requires the referral of all proposed
2 legislative matters to a Committee, and then approves the adoption of the resolution by at least six
3 votes. If the motion to waive the provisions of Rule 2.11 fails, then the resolution may not be voted
4 upon at that Board meeting, and the Clerk of the Board shall refer it to Committee.
