

1 [Accept-Expend federal grant funds to support HIV/AIDS services.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**  
4 **and expend a funding award entitled the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Treatment Modernization**  
5 **Act Grant (Ryan White Part A Program) in the amount of \$4,758,228 for the San**  
6 **Francisco Eligible Metropolitan Area from the Health Resources and Services**  
7 **Administration (HRSA) to support HIV/AIDS health services; for the period of February**  
8 **1, 2009 through June 30, 2009.**

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10 WHEREAS, HRSA awarded the San Francisco Eligible Metropolitan Area (SF-EMA),  
11 including San Francisco, Marin and San Mateo counties, a Ryan White Part A Program grant  
12 in the amount of \$4,758,228 for the period of February 1, 2009 through June 30, 2009; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Ryan White Part A Program supports a multitude of health services to  
14 HIV positive persons residing in the SF-EMA; and,

15 WHEREAS, Only 10 percent of the total award amount may be used for administrative  
16 costs, which includes planning council support expenses, and the remaining 90 percent is  
17 distributed among Community Based Organizations (CBOs) to provide direct services to  
18 clients; and,

19 WHEREAS, The grant budget does not include a provision for indirect costs because  
20 the funder does not allow it; and,

21 WHEREAS, DPH has not yet received a funding award letter or agreement from  
22 HRSA, but the funding allocation is included in the federal budget, allowing the accept and  
23 expend approval process to proceed on the local level to avoid funding delays among  
24 HIV/AIDS service providers who are in need of funds; and,

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1 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment because no positions are  
2 being created or funded through DPH; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the  
4 amount of \$4,758,228 from HRSA; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the  
6 grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
8 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
10 indirect costs in the grant budget.
