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8	WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works (DPW), working together with the San
9	Francisco Planning Department, identified McCoppin Street west of Valencia Street as a
10	street that could be closed to motor vehicle traffic and transformed into a plaza and
11	community garden that would provide open space to the South of Market Street community;
12	and
13	WHEREAS, Based on these findings, DPW prepared plans to transform McCoppin
14	Street west of Valencia Street into a community garden and plaza; and
15	WHEREAS, The design plan for McCoppin Street west of Valencia Street includes: the
16	demolition of the existing asphalt road surface; replacing the old sewer main and side sewers;
17	repaving the roadway with decorative cobblestone flush with existing sidewalks for improved

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WHEREAS, A portion of the street and the existing sidewalk will be left accessible for continued bicycle and pedestrian access to Market Street on the north side of McCoppin Street; and

accessibility; adding a community garden with planter boxes, potting tables, seat walls,

compost bins, foot paths, and perimeter lighting and fencing; and installing three ornamental

light standards and decorative pre-cast paving blocks. A copy of the design plan is on file with

the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 090866 and is attached hereto by reference;

WHEREAS, By letter dated March 13, 2009, the Planning Department determined that
the vehicular street closure of and pedestrian improvements to McCoppin Street west of
Valencia Street were, on balance, consistent with the Market and Octavia Neighborhood
Plan; consistent with City's General Plan and the priority policies of Planning Code Section
101.1; and determined that the actions contemplated in this Ordinance are in compliance with
the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et
seq.) because the proposed improvements to McCoppin Street were evaluated at a project
level in the Market and Octavia Street Neighborhood Plan Environmental Impact Report
certified by the Planning Department in 2008, a copy of which is available at the Planning
Department, 1660 Mission Street, 4 th Floor, as part of File No. 2003.0347E, and which is
incorporated herein by reference; and
WHEREAS, On September 22, 2005, at a duly noticed public hearing, the
Interdepartmental Staff Committee On Traffic and Transportation (ISCOTT) recommended the
vehicular street closure of McCoppin Street west of Valencia Street; and
WHEREAS, On May 19, 2009, at a duly noticed public hearing, the Municipal
Transportation Agency approved the vehicular street closure of McCoppin Street west of
Valencia Street; and
WHEREAS, On March 25, 2009, the Director of DPW in DPW Order No. 178,118
recommended that this Board take various actions in relation to the closure of McCoppin
Street west of Valencia to vehicular traffic, including approving the vehicular street closure
and authorizing the expenditure of funds to install the community garden along McCoppin
Street. A copy of the DPW Order is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File
No. 090866 and is attached hereto by reference; now, therefore, be it

1	RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code
2	and Streets and Highways Code, the San Francisco Traffic Code, and San Francisco
3	Administrative Code Section 1.51, the Board of Supervisors hereby enacts the following
4	regulation governing the movement of vehicles as designated below:
5	Establish McCoppin Street west of Valencia Street as a street closed to vehicular traffic
6	at all times; and, be it
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors affirms the Planning Department's
8	environmental determination and adopts as its own the Planning Department's findings of
9	consistency with the City's General Plan and the priority policies of Planning Code Section
10	101.1 that are set forth in the Planning Department's March 13, 2009 letter; and, be it
11	FURTHER RESOLVED, The Board authorizes DPW to incur costs and take all
12	necessary actions to construct the above mentioned improvements and community garden on
13	McCoppin Street; and, be it
14	FURTHER RESOLVED, The Board authorizes all necessary actions to effectuate the
15	intent of the closing McCoppin Street west of Valencia to motor vehicle traffic and
16	implementing the pedestrian improvements described herein.
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
