1	WHEREAS, The Executive Director/CEO of the MTA (or his designee) must execute		
2	agreements to complete transfer of the funds; now, therefore, be it		
3	RESOLVED, That on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, the MTA is		
4	authorized to accept and expend \$25 million in STA funds from the MTC for construction and		
5	construction support of Muni's IOS and Metro East facility; and, be it		
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives inclusion of indirect		
7	costs in the grant budget; and, be it		
8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to furnish whatever additional		
9	information or assurances may be requested by the funding agencies in connection with this		
10	request; and, be it		
11	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to execute any and all agreements
