

1 [Accept and Expend State Grant – Career Criminal Prosecution]

3 **Resolution authorizing retroactively the District Attorney of the City and County of San**
4 **Francisco to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$197,178 made available**
5 **through The Office of Criminal Justice Planning for a project entitled “Career Criminal**
6 **Prosecution” to fund vertical prosecution of career criminals.**

8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to continue a certain project
9 designated the San Francisco Career Criminal Prosecution Program to be funded in part from
10 funds made available through the Office of Criminal Justice Planning (hereafter “OCJP”); and,

11 WHEREAS, No matching funds are required for said project under the Career Criminal
12 Prosecution Program and the rules and regulations of OCJP; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on
14 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in
16 the grant budget; and be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District
18 Attorney of the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend funds
19 from OCJP for the purposes of career criminal prosecution; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of
21 the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreements for career
22 criminal prosecution purposes including any extensions, augmentations or amendments
23 thereof; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant
2 Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the
3 grant recipient and the authorizing agency; and be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to
5 supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
